Sophie Larivière (Recorder)

Artistic Co-Director of Ensemble Caprice, Sophie has performed with the ensemble in Europe, Israel, Canada and the United States, including the Boston Early Music Festival. Performances with other early music ensembles include the Opéra de Montréal, Le Studio de musique ancienne de Montréal, and Rebel (New York). She has made numerous recordings and lives with her husband, Matthias Maute and two children in Montreal, Quebec.

Matthias Maute (Recorder)

Known internationally as a conductor, recorder and flute player, and composer, he is co-artistic director of Ensemble Caprice, which performs at major festivals world wide. Many of his contemporary recorder music compositions are widely performed and published. He has made numerous recordings on the Analekta, Vanguard Classics, Bella Musica, Dorian, Bridge and Atma Classique labels. He teaches at Université de Montréal and McGill University in Montreal.

David Morris (Viol)

A member of The King's Noyse, the Galax Quartet, Quicksilver and NYS Baroque, he has performed with the Boston Early Music Festival Orchestra, Tragicomedia, Tafelmusik, the Boston Symphony Orchestra, Philharmonia Baroque Orchestra, Musica Pacifica, American Bach Soloists, & others. He was founder and musical director of the baroque opera ensemble Teatro Bachino. He has been a guest instructor in early music performance-practice at UC Berkeley, UC Santa Cruz, the San Francisco Conservatory of Music, Oberlin College, Cornell University & others. He has made numerous recordings.

Directions: By Road/Water Taxi: Take a scenic ferry ride from the mainland at Tsawassen or Horseshoe Bay to Nanaimo. Drive north on Hwy 19, the main island highway, and turn off just past marker 320 onto an unpaved logging road marked Zeballos/Fair Harbour. At Fair Harbour, park in the main parking lot near the government dock, then board your reserved water taxi for a magnificent 30-40 minute boat ride through the mountainous waterways to Kyuquot.

Places to stay along the way: We recommend that you spend one overnight on your way to Kyuquot. Enjoy your stay at one of these affordable, clean and comfortable accommodations: Campbell River—Passage View Motel (1-877-286-1156), Heritage River Inn (1-800-567-2007).




